

Call for Papers

Mitekufat Haeven - Journal of the Israel Prehistoric Society

We are now accepting submissions for volume 55 of *Mitekufat Haeven - Journal of the Israel Prehistoric Society* (JIPS). JIPS has served scholars interested in Near Eastern prehistory since 1960. It covers all fields of research pertaining to the prehistory and protohistory of the Levant, up to and including the Chalcolithic. **We publish original and innovative articles and reports that deal with descriptive or theoretical archaeological research. We publish data-rich articles, including excavation reports, lab analyses, short notes and book reviews.**

In view of the fact that Volume 55 will mark the centenary of prehistoric excavations in Israel, we are especially interested in receiving papers related to this topic.

JIPS is peer-reviewed and published yearly (in December) as a full-color volume. The journal is published in English, with extended Hebrew and Arabic summaries of each article. All authors receive PDF files of their papers and can share them **privately** (there is a two-year embargo on uploading PDFs to public internet sites such as Academia.edu or ResearchGate or personal webpages). All content is available online in JSTOR.

Submission of manuscripts, books to be reviewed, *etc.*, is now open year-round. Submissions will be handled upon arrival, and accepted articles will be published in a pre-print version when ready. In tandem, contributions should be submitted no later than 1st May in order to be considered for the volume of that year. For book reviews, a single hard copy of the book to be reviewed in the journal (the copy will not be returned) should be sent to Uri Davidovich, Institute of Archaeology, The Hebrew University, Jerusalem 9190501, Israel.
